

Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

Change in the Amounts of the Individual Fee: Zambia

1. The Government of Zambia has notified to the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) a declaration modifying the amounts of the individual fee payable with respect to Zambia under Article 8(7) of the Madrid Protocol.
2. As from January 21, 2021, the amounts of the individual fee payable in respect of Zambia will be the following:

3. These new amounts will be payable where Zambia
 - (a) is designated in an international application which is received by the Office of origin on or after January 21, 2021; or
 - (b) is the subject of a subsequent designation which is received by the Office of the Contracting Party of the holder on or after January 21, 2021, or is filed directly with the International Bureau of WIPO on or after that date; or
 - (c) has been designated in an international registration which is renewed on or after January 21, 2021.
