

Madrid Protocol Concerning the International Registration of Marks

Change in the Amounts of the Individual Fee: Singapore

1. It is recalled that the Government of Singapore notified to the Director General of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) a declaration modifying the amounts of the individual fee payable with respect to Singapore under Article 8(7) of the Madrid Protocol (see [Information Notice No. 8/2022](#)).
2. The Director General of WIPO has received a further communication from the Government of Singapore informing WIPO that the new amounts of the individual fee payable in respect of Singapore will be applied as from May 26, 2022, instead of May 8, 2022, as earlier communicated.
3. Therefore, as from May 26, 2022, the amounts of the individual fee payable in respect of Singapore will be the following:

Renewal	– for each class of goods or services	270	302

4. These new amounts will be payable where Singapore

(a) is designated in an international application which is received by the Office of origin on or after May 26, 2022; or

(b) is the subject of a subsequent designation which is received by the Office of the Contracting Party of the holder on or after May 26, 2022, or is filed directly with the International Bureau of WIPO on or after that date; or

(c) has been designated in an international registration which is renewed on or after May 26, 2022.
