The registration form will allow representatives to indicate whether they will participate in the meeting on-site or remotely, and if they expect to have a speaking role.

Participants who indicate on the registration form that they will participate remotely will be contacted in advance of the start of the forty-sixth IPC Revision Working Group session concerning technical modalities for accessing the meeting via the online platform, and will be invited to a short, individual connectivity test/training session before the meeting.

WIPO encourages gender equality in all its meetings, and it would be appreciated if this could be taken into account when nominating the participants.
