I. <u>Introduction</u>

WIPO

1.AtthesessionoftheWIPOGeneralAssembly,heldinGenevafromSeptember23toOctober1,2002,theGeneralAssemblydecidedtoestablishasingleAdvisoryCommitteeonEnforcement,inchargeofglobalenforcementissues,coveringbothindustrialpropertyandcopyrightandrelatedrights. ThemandateoftheCommittee,whichexcludesnorm-settingactivities,waslimitedtotechnicalassistanceandcoordination.TheCommitteehasthefollowingobjectives:coordinatingwithcertainorganizationsandtheprivatesectortocombatcounterfeitingandpiracy;publiceducation;assistance;coordinationtoundertakenationalandregionaltrainingprogramsforallrelevantstakeholdersandexchangeofinformationonenforcementissuesthroughtheestablishmentofanElectronicForum.eattranspaceattranspace

2. Itisrecalledthat duringthefirstsessionoftheAdvisoryCommitteeonthe EnforcementofIndustrialPropertyRights(ACE/IP),heldinGeneva onOctober19and20, 2000,theACE/IPproposedthattheSecretariatofWIPOinitiatefourstudies,assetforthin paragraph8(a)(i)to(iv)ofdocumentACE/IP/1/3(*SummarybytheChair*).Pursuanttothat $proposal, the Secretariat of WIPO submitted a qu estion naire, entitled Request for Information, {}^{1} to members and observers of the above Committee.$

3. TheSecretariatofWIPOreceived repliesfrom24MemberStates,two intergovernmentaland11non -governmentalorganizations inresponsetothesa idrequest. DocumentWIPO/CME/2Rev." *ExistingNeedsforTrainingandforDevelopmentof EnforcementStrategies*" wasestablishedbytheSecretariatofWIPOonthebasisofthese responses.

4. ThisdocumentwaspresentedfordiscussiontotheCo nsultationMeetingon Enforcement(CME)inGenevafromSeptember11to13,2002. TheMeetingwasattended byMemberStates,intergovernmentalorganizationsandnon -governmentalorganizations.

TheMeeting unanimously agreed that the issue of enforcement of intellectual property 5. rightswasofgreatimportanceandthatWIPOwasinaneminentlyappropriatepositionto providetechnicalassistanceandeducationandcontributetothecreationofawarenessinthis field.ItalsoencouragedWIPOto assist, and coordinate with relevant organizations, in the settingupof, or improving, adequate and effective enforcement mechanisms .TheMeeting notedtheconcernsexpressedabouttheeffectsofcounterfeitingandpiracyondomestic industries and stres sed that the fight against these phenomenawas a global concern. It also took note of the activities of the International Bureau reflected in the tables attached to the second sedocument WIPO/CME/2Rev.andexpresseditsgreatappreciationfortheconsiderableand high-qualityworkalreadyundertakenbytheRegionalBureausofCooperationfor DevelopmentandtheWIPOWorldWideAcademyinthefieldofenforcement.Itwas, however, observed that there was room for improvement indetermining the recipients of the WIPOte chnicalassistanceandthesubstanceofsuchassistance.

II. EnforcementandSpecialProjectsDivision

6. SubsequenttothesessionoftheGeneralAssembly,theDirectorGeneralestablished theEnforcementandSpecialProjectsDivisiontoserv easafocalpointforenforcement activitiesintheInternationalBureau.TheDivisionisactivelycooperatingwith intergovernmentalorganizationsintheareaofenforcementand incontact withthecompetent authoritiesinMemberStatesaswe llaswithnon -governmentalorganization.Italsoplaysa pivotalroleinthecoordinationofenforcementactivitieswithintheInternationalBureau.

7. TheDivisionhas, *interalia*, thefollowingresponsibilities: the convening and supporting the annual meeting of the Advisory Committee on Enforcement to consider intellectual property enforcement is sues and strategies; giving effect to decision staken by the former Advisory Committee on Enforcement of Industrial Property Rights, Advisory Committee on Enforcement of Copyright and Related Rights in Global Information Networks and the Consultation Meeting on Enforcement in the broader contexts of all intellectual property rights; preparation of additional working documents, studies and surveys on topical issues relating to the enforcement of Industrial Property rights; administering the Electronic Forumon Intellectual Property Enforcement Issues and Strategies (IPEIS), as a forum where all relevant stakeholders can share information on al experience spertaining to the enforcement of intellectual property rights; cooperation and coordination with multilater al

andregionalorganizationsandwithnon -governmentalorganizationsinordertoshare expertiseandexperiencesinthefieldofthe enforcementofintellectualpropertyrights, includingtheattendanceofseminars,workshopsandothermeetings;promotingthe understandingoftheinternationalobligationsandprinciplesrelatingtotheenforcementof intellectualpropertyrightsanda ddressingtheneedsofMemberStatesindevelopingand strengtheningtheirnationalandregionalsystemsfortheenforcementofintellectualproperty rights,includingcorrespondence,humanresourcedevelopment,participatinginseminarsand workshops,adv isingnationalgovernmentsontheimplementationofenforcementstrategies, providinglegislativeadviceandtechnicalassistance;anddevelopingprojectsand informationmaterialtoenhancepublicawarenessinthefightagainstcounterfeitingand piracy.

IV. NeedsforFurtherTrainingandforDevelopmentofEnforcementStrategies

9 astheConsultationMeetingonEnforcement heldin2002 Itshouldbenotedthat concentrated predominantly on issues relating to the status and mandate of the futureAdvisoryCommitteeonEnforcement,documentWIPO/CME/2Rev.on *"ExistingNeedsfor* TrainingandforDevelopmentofEnforcementStrategies" wasnotdiscussedindetail during thatMeeting. There are several reasons for which it is considered to be important that the Committee, in addition to taking note of recent activities of the International Bureau in the fieldoftheenforcementofintellectualpropertyrights,exam inestheissuesreferredtoin documentWIPO/CME/2Rev.inmoredetail.First,theMeetinghadencouragedMember States and observers that had not yet do ne so to submitto the Secretaria to fWIPO repliesand information² concerning the subject matter of t hisdocumentinordertohaveabroaderbasis for the envisaged discussions there on. Second, the Meeting also agreed that it was important to ensure that the issues dealt within the document, and during the discussion on the document, would be taken intaccount informulating the development cooperation activities of WIPO. Third, it is one of the current tasks of the Committee to decide on its future work the committee to the current tasks of the committee to the current tasks of the cuonthebasisofalltheinformationwhichhasbeenprovided.

10. Pursuanttothe above proposalbytheCMEtoencourageallmembersandobservers to submitfur therinformation pertaining to the issues raised indocument WIPO/CME/2Rev., the Secretariatof WIPO once again invited ³ members and observers to respond to the said

questionnaireand toalsoprovide *,interalia* ,informationontheiractivitiesinthefieldof enforcement,suchasplannedseminars,workshops,on -the-jobtrainingandusefultraining material.TheSecretariatofWIPOreceived16responsesfrom15MemberStates ⁴ and seven non-governmentalorganizations ⁵toitsrenewedandextendedrequestforinformation. In viewofthelimitednumberofadditionalresponsesreceivedatthetimeofpreparationof thisdocument,theinformationwasnotsufficientforasubstantialrevision oftheworking documentpreparedfortheConsultationMeetingonEnforcement.Againstthisbackground, theSecretariatdecidednottoincorporateamendmentsintodocumentWIPO/CME/2Rev.and nottomakeanattempttopresentanupdatethereofasaworkin gdocumentforthisMeeting. Instead,theresponsestotherenewedrequestforinformationarebeingmadeavailableonthe IntellectualPropertyEnforcementIssuesandStrategies(IPEIS)ElectronicForum.
