Thank you Mr. President

From the last two days's sessions, many States raised serious concern that new emerging technology is putting unprecedented burdens on the current IP regimes. If we are to realize "IP 4.0" to facilitate fairness and to benefit the people of the world. We must all work together to deal with new real challenges, address the needs of the real world and benefit people. WIPO is in the position to take the lead to serve its members' people.
