## Item 15. Report on the Standing Committee on the Law of Patents (SCP) (WO/GA/50/4)

Mr. Chair,

- 1. The CEBS Group welcomes the work of the Standing Committee on the Law of Patents and would like to thank the chair of the SCP Mr. Damaso Pardo for guiding the work in the last two sessions. We would also like to express our gratitude to the Deputy Director General Mr. John Sandage and the Secretariat for their work over the past year including the preparation for this General Assembly.
- 2. We believe that this committee is of great importance as a forum for the member states to exchange the experiences and share the best practices in the area of the patent law, as well as to gain from information and discussions on different important topics, especially in the area of substantive patent law.
- 3. The CEBS group is pleased to note that constructive participation of delegations engaged in the work of the committee allowed for tangible progress in discussions on the five main topics of the SCP and for reaching agreement on balanced future work programme.
