CURRICULUM VITAE OF MS. WANG BINYING

Ms. Wang Binying, a national of China, joined the International Bureau of WIPO in April 1992, as a Senior Program Officer in the Bureau for Development Cooperation for Asia and the Pacific. In 1994 she became a Counsellor of the Office of the Director General, and in 1996 was promoted to the position of Senior Counsellor where she had responsibility for overseeing the routine administrative work of the Office of the Director General. In addition to those functions, she was put in charge of the coordination, organization and documentation for the Assemblies of the Member States of WIPO. In November 1997 she assumed the position of Senior Counsellor in the Office for Strategic Planning and Policy Development (OSPPD) with an expanded portfolio of work in the OSPPD in addition to the duties mentioned above. In March 1999 she was promoted to the position of Director, Inter-Office and General Assembly Affairs, OSPPD. In December 2003, Ms. Wang was promoted to the position of Executive Director of Administrative Support Services and General Assembly Affairs (ASGA).

Ms. Wang's academic background is in English language, communication, transportation and law. She graduated from the Zhongnan University in Changsha in China, and holds a Master's degree in Law, including industrial property, from the Law School of University of California (Berkeley) in the United States of America. She was also awarded a Diploma in American Law from the Columbia Law School in New York.

Prior to joining WIPO, Ms. Wang was an official and research officer in the Ministry of Communication and Transportation of China from 1975 to 1980, during which time she was stationed in the United Republic of Tanzania and Zambia. She later served in the Department for Registration and Supervision of Foreign Company and Trade-names in the State Administration for Industry and Commerce (SAIC), and became Acting Director General of that department in 1988. In 1990, she was appointed to head the China Trademark Service (as Managing Director), an institution concerned with trademark issues under the SAIC.
