加入联合国可持续发展集团

秘书处编拟

1. 世界知识产权组织（产权组织）受邀成为联合国可持续发展集团（可持续发展集团）成员（邀请函载于附件）。
2. 在关于联合国系统发展方面业务活动四年度全面政策审查（四年度全面政策审查）的第 71/243 号决议中，联合国大会呼吁为集体行动制定全系统战略文件，以支持落实《2030 年可持续发展议程》。针对这一呼吁，联合国秘书长提交了一份题为“将联合国发展系统重新定位以实现《2030 年议程》：确保人人享有一个更美好的未来”的报告（A/72/124-E/2018/3）。联合国秘书长为重新定位联合国系统提出了七项措施，包括一份全系统战略文件，以确保集体责任和加快协调联合国发展系统，支持 2030 年议程。该全系统战略文件除其他行动外，还包括振兴联合国发展集团（发展集团），以加强关于本系统在国家层面为落实议程所作贡献的战略方向、公正监督和问责。发展集团已更名为可持续发展集团，由众多联合国机构和方案组成（名单载于附件）。
3. 在考虑成为可持续发展集团成员的邀请后，产权组织总干事要求提供以下信息：在产权组织的预估费用分摊中，拟用于支持驻地协调员实地工作的份额，以及拟用于支持在全球范围落实可持续发展目标的份额。在此背景下，产权组织总干事表示，产权组织的诸多计划和服务主要采取数字和虚拟形式，这也体现在超过 95% 的产权组织工作人员在日内瓦总部工作，有鉴于此，本组织对驻地协调员系统的使用远远少于其他机构。
4. 成为可持续发展集团成员的财务影响预计为每两年期 40 万瑞郎。成员费用分摊公式目前正在四年度全面政策审查的讨论框架中进行审查，并将在即将召开的联合国大会上通过。

5. 除财务影响之外，成为可持续发展集团成员还可能会带来行政和报告方面的影响。

6. 请计划和预算委员会（PBC）审议本文件（WO/PBC/31/10）及其附件中所载的对产权组织成为可持续发展集团成员的邀请。

Dear Mr. Gurry,

I am writing to you in my capacity as Chair of the United Nations Development Group (UNDG) to invite the World Intellectual Property Organization to become a member of the renewed UNDG.

A recalibrated and impactful UNDG – more inclusive in its composition – is a critical stepping stone in the efforts of the Secretary-General to reposition the United Nations development system (UNDS). The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development is indeed a paradigm shift in the way we deliver support to countries and the people we serve – individually and across the system. Responding effectively will require significant changes in the skill sets, leadership and accountability mechanisms of the UNDS, with the UNDG at its center.

Moving forward, the UNDG will need increased capacities to steer and provide greater strategic direction, oversight and accountability to the UNDS. This is particularly true at the country level, where we envision the emergence of a new generation of United Nations country teams – guided by an enhanced and responsive United Nations development assistance framework and led by empowered and impartial Resident Coordinators.

In the coming weeks, the recalibrated UNDG will be renamed into the “United Nations Sustainable Development Group” (UNSDG). It will include all entities of the United Nations system that contribute significantly to the implementation of the Sustainable Development Goals at the country level. The observer status is to be eliminated. The list of proposed UNDG members has been updated accordingly, as outlined in the enclosed document.

In this regard, I would be delighted if you could join us for our forthcoming Principals meeting on Wednesday, 2 May 2018 at the International Organization for Migration Headquarters in London. The meeting will serve to discuss system-wide priority actions in support of the reform agenda of the Secretary-General to reposition the UNDS for the 2030 Agenda.
