What kind of protection does an industrial design right offer?


Right to prevent third parties from:



Articles bearing or enbodying a design which is a copy, or substantially a copy, of the protected designs when such acts are undertaken for commercial purposes.

How to obtain protection for an industrial design?

■ Filing with the intellectual property (IP) office of the country (or region)



■ Filing with the Hague System (an entitlement to file is required)





Applying for industrial design protection

- Must fulfill some or all of the following criteria: novetly, originality
- Granted by the IP Office of the country (or region) where the application is filed
- May file the application yourself or may be required to appoint an agent (depending on applicable law)
- Rights are territorial: limited to the country (or region) where protection is granted
- Timing is important: in general, before publicly disclosing it



Makes a product attractive and appealing to customers.



 Drives consumer's choice and can be a key factor in the purchase decision.



May lead to success or failure of a product.



Advantages to businesses of protecting their industrial designs? (1)




■ Return on investments

Protection contributes to obtaining a return on investments made in creating and marketing attractive and innovative products.



Exclusive rights

Protection provides exclusive rights for at least 10 years, so as to prevent or stop others from commercially exploiting or copying the industrial design.



Strengthen brands

Industrial designs can be an important element of a company's brand. Protecting industrial designs contributes to protecting a company's brand.



Advantages to businesses of protecting their industrial designs? (2)



Opportunity to license/sell

Protection provides rights that may be sold or licensed to another enterprise (source of income for the owner of the rights).



Positive image

Protection helps convey a positive image of a company, since industrial designs are business assets which may increase the market value of a company and its products.



Reward and creativity

Protecting industrial designs rewards and encourages creativity.
