#### **Introduction to the Budapest Treaty**

- (a) Deposit of Microorganisms for the Purposes of Patent Procedure
  - i. Disclosure and the Requirement for Deposit
    - 1. A fundamental requirement of patent law is that the details of an invention must be fully disclosed to the public. For disclosure to be adequate, an invention must be described in sufficient detail to permit a person skilled in the art to repeat the effect of the invention (...) Moreover, if the microorganism was not generally available to the public, the written disclosure of the invention might be held to be insufficient...
















The Nagoya Protocol on Access to Genetic Resources and the Fair and Equitable Sharing of Benefits Arising from their Utilization to the Convention on Biological Diversity

International agreement

Aims at sharing the benefits arising from the **utilization** of genetic resources in a fair and equitative way

Convention on

Entered into force on 12 October 2014

Change of paradigm: from free access to sovereign rights (CBD art. 15)

- Faculty to regulate the access to the genetic resources (CBD art. 15.1)
- Conditions to facilitate the access to the genetic resources (CBD art. 15.2)






# Article 3 Recognition and Effect of the Deposit of Microorganisms

(2) As far as matters regulated in this Treaty and the Regulations are concerned, no Contracting State may require compliance with requirements different from or additional to those which are provided in this Treaty and the Regulations

Budapest Treaty on the International Recognition of the Deposit of Microorganisms for the Purposes of Patent Procedure





# **Article 4 Relationship with international agreements and instruments**

1. The provisions of this Protocol shall not affect the rights and obligations of any Party deriving from any existing international agreement, except where the exercise of those rights and obligations would cause a serious damage or threat to biological diversity. This paragraph is not intended to create a hierarchy between this Protocol and other international instruments



#### Due diligence and furnishing of samples

Rule 11.2

Strains are furnished to the depositor or with his/her authorization

The **depositor** must provide the third party all the ABS related information







#### Due diligence and furnishing of samples

#### Rule 11.3

The **depositor** must provide the information to the third party

The depositor is informed **after** the strain is furnished

- The required information / documentation does not arrive to the third party with the strain
- The depositor cannot be reached





#### Due diligence and furnishing of samples

#### Rule 11.3

The depositor is informed **after** the strain is furnished



The IDA should send the strain with all the information / documentation on request

Minimal information requested to comply with due diligence

- Material situation with respect to the ABS
- Prove legal accession in the country of origin and information on the Mutually Agreed Terms





**Budapest treaty deposits** 

Minimal information requested to comply with due diligence

Material situation with respect to the ABS

- Depositor identification for the material (reference of identification)
- Taxonomical designation (proposed taxonomic designation)
- IDAs identification for the material (accession number)
- Date of accession in the country of origin
- Place of accession, including country of origin and geographical coordinates when posible
- Name of the accesor and the name of the institution in the moment of the accesion.

Minimal information requested to comply with due diligence

Prove legal accession in the country of origin and information on the Mutually Agreed Terms
