
Principles on Digital platforms:

To provide platforms centred around serving users, and the Kingdom's endeavour to enable digital platforms and adopt innovative modern business models.

Principles on Innovation:

To provide a stimulating environment for creativity and innovation in areas related to the digital economy by promoting the principle of respecting intellectual property rights and achieving a balance between the interests of innovators and the public interest in accordance with national laws and regulations.

IPR's in the Metaverse



IP related Studies & Consultations

SAIP has taken the following actions with regards to the Metaverse:

SAIP Metaverse task force

 Specifically catering to following emerging trends and assessing updates.

SAIP Advisory Board

- Enactment of special laws for metaverse.
- Sufficiency of the current IP laws to adopt at the metaverse.
- Use of Metaverse in the IP management processes.

- Regulatory updates should only be introduced after thorough analysis.
- Using the metaverse and blockchain in the patent management processes is advisable.
- At this stage, metaverse and blockchain technologies are already covered by current IP legal regime, to some extent.

Current and targeted actions from SAIP



 Regulations for Optional Registration of Copyrighted works enacted in 2021.



National IP Strategy launched in 2022 and aims to:

- Increase in the production of 3D and aims to Promote the content industry with the expansion of the market,
- Supporting the development of technologies such as VR programs, AR, and mixed reality in Saudi Arabia,
- Help diversify the content traded in the market,
- Increasing the demand for 3D content.



IP Legal regime updates to be considered

 Accession to treaties such as WIPO Copyright treaty, and Madrid Protocol for international registration of marks



- National IP Policy updates to be introduced in respect to:
- Emerging intellectual property issues related to new digital technologies, including artificial intelligence, Blockchain, virtual reality, metaverse, and others'.

Actionable steps for IPO & Regulators



- On the importance of prior IPR management and registration (if possible).
- The importance of effective IP clauses in licenses and (digital/legal) contracts.



Keep an open dialogue with major stakeholders

• Strengthen the association and communication between major tech players and IPO's.



- Adopt a Sandbox approach "Create then regulate" (if possible).
- Adaptation/Update of existing laws before introducing new ones.
