

Trade Secrets - What do I have?

The fine line between contextual information and assets

The User defines the type of protection:


Is the confidential information owned by my organization a trade secret in the sense of a standalone IP asset – or is it merely know-how providing contextual (enablement) information to another IP asset, e.g. a patent or a utility model?



Trade Secrets - As Contextual Information

Does my Trade Secret have standalone value?

- If the trade secret is merely contextual information, it can be stored as documentation with another IP asset.
- As such, it can be made available to licensees of the IP asset for added value.






Trade Secrets - As Assets

Does my Trade Secret have standalone value?

- If the trade secret has standalone value, it can be captured as its own IP asset.
- As such, it can be licensed separately from any other IP assets.
