 - to effectively access, use and manage IP from ideation to commercialization; and

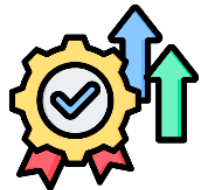
Increase in IP awareness and knowledge

→ *Outreach and training activities by TISCs reach local researchers, innovators and entrepreneurs*



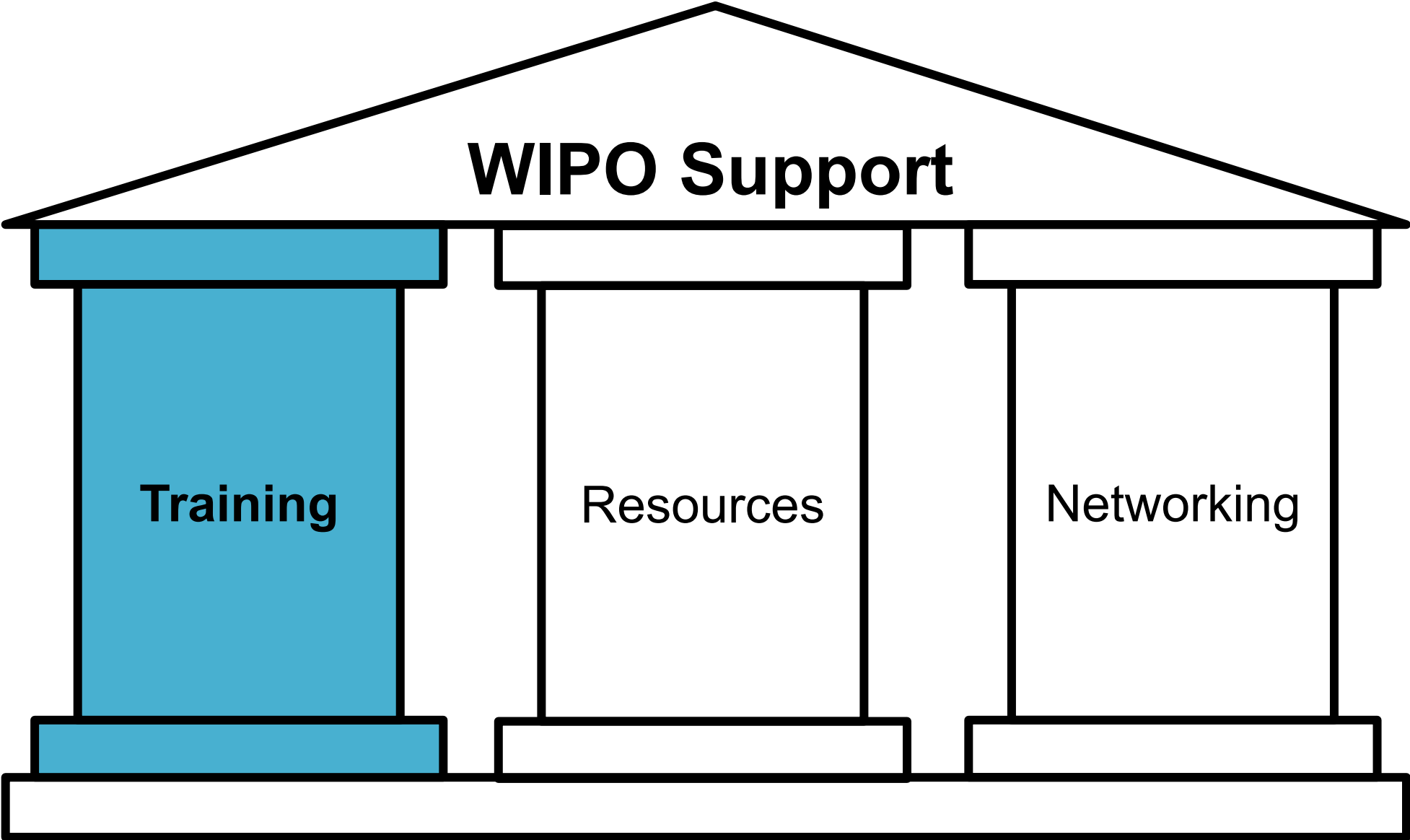
TISCs as catalysts for filing patent and other IPR applications

→ *Income from commercialized IP from TISCs in PH in 2024: over 350,000 USD*

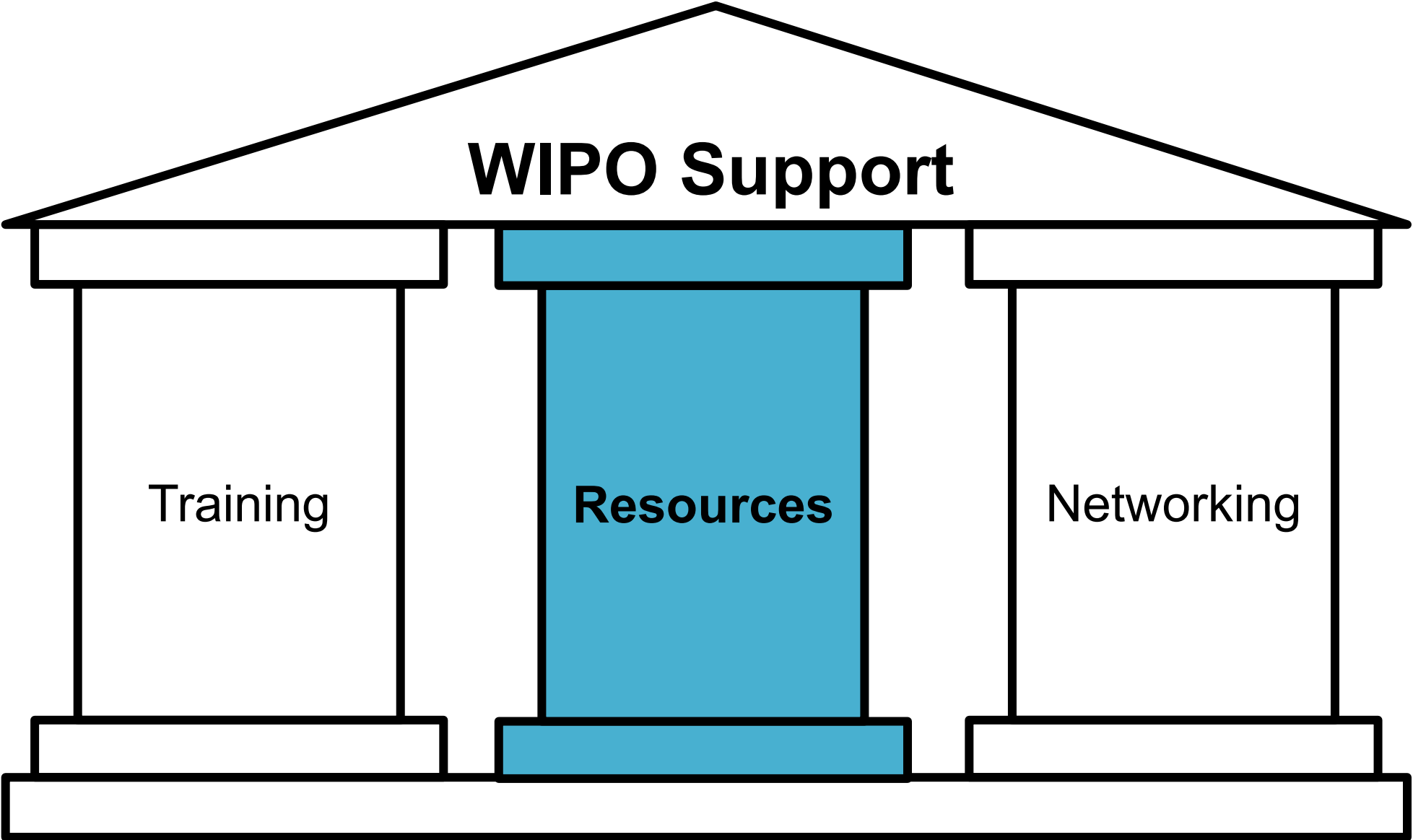



8-month experience for patent professionals to develop skills. Includes mentorship and exam

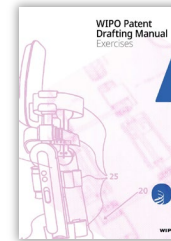

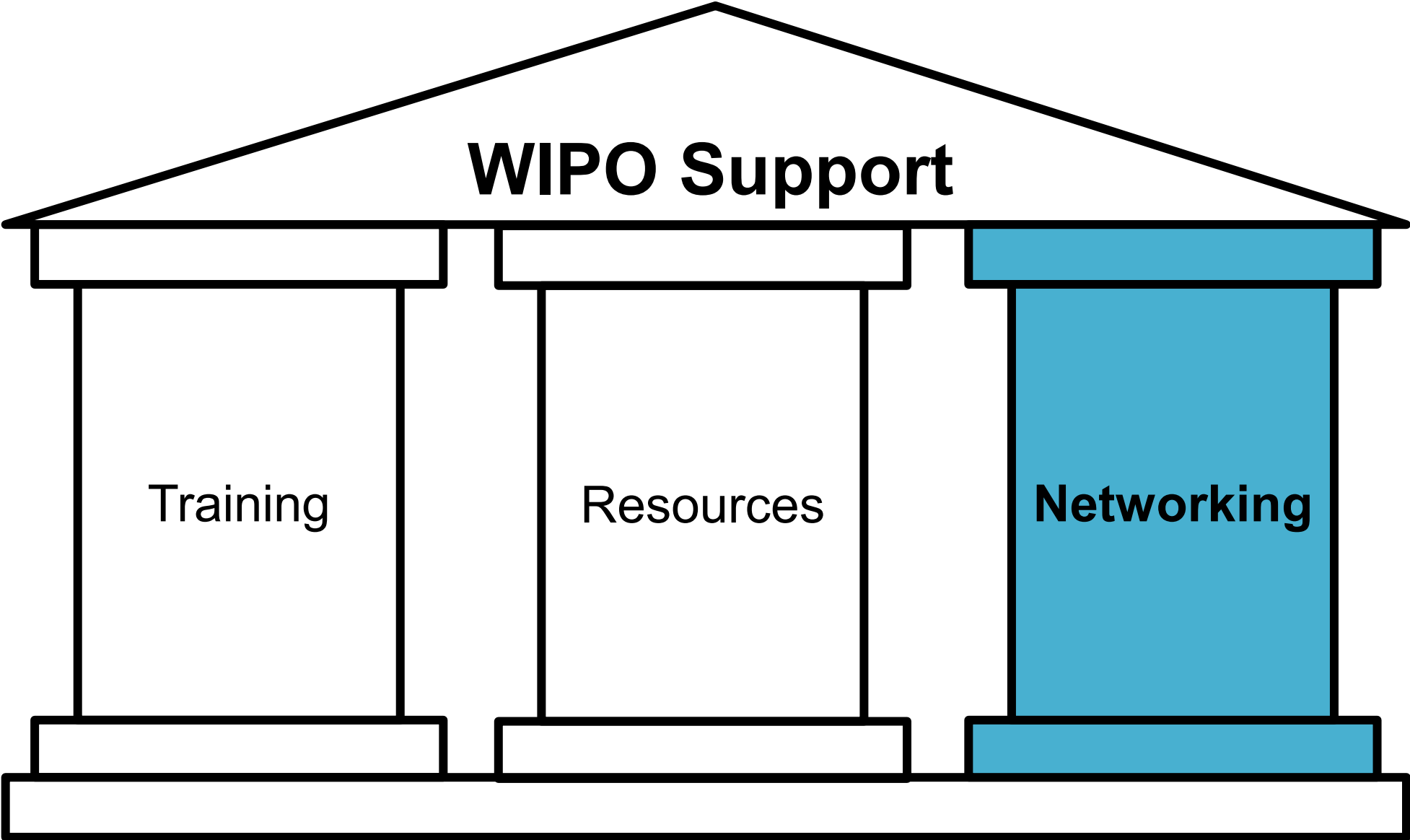

Inventor Assistance Program (IAP)

- Individual inventors and small businesses from participating countries who meet the local eligibility criteria determined by each country qualify as beneficiaries
- Qualifying inventors receive pro-bono help securing patents or utility models in their country and internationally, including through the PCT system
- Beneficiaries can also get guidance for commercializing patents supported by the Program
