Géraldine is Director of International Affairs at SACD (Société des Auteurs Compositeurs Dramatiques) and has more than 25 years of experience at SACD, where she previously held various positions in the international department.

She oversees the negotiation of contracts of representation with foreign CMOs administering the performing arts and the audiovisual repertoires and particularly focuses on the development and follow-up of such contracts from an operational and technical point of view.

She also supervises the administration and the development of IDA (International Database of Audiovisual works), which is a tool enabling the identification of foreign works and their rights holders, currently used by 43 audiovisual CMOs member of CISAC worldwide.

She was also previously Chair of the CISAC Technical Committee of Dramatic Litterary and Audiovisual Societies (CTDLV) between 2018 and 2021 and Coordinator of the French Coalition for Cultural Diversity between 2007 and 2010.
