He is the founder and editor-in-chief of the *Interactive Entertainment Law Review*, Edward Elgar, the producer of the *More Than Just a Game* conference series; the co-author of *Mastering the Game* 2nd edition, WIPO, and a video games enthusiast.

Dr. Eleonora Rosati is Full Professor of Intellectual Property Law and Director of the Institute for Intellectual Property and Market Law (IFIM) at Stockholm University.

Eleonora is also Of Counsel at Bird & Bird and holds visiting/guest professorships at Católica in Lisbon and CEIPI in Strasbourg.

She is a long-standing contributor to The IPKat and an Editor of the Journal of Intellectual Property Law & Practice (Oxford University Press).

Eleonora is the author of several scholarly articles and books on IP issues, including – most recently – *Copyright and the Court of Justice of the European Union* and *Copyright in the Digital Single Market - Article-by-Article Commentary to the Provisions of Directive 2019/790*.

Eleonora has been the recipient of accolades and prizes for her work in and impact on the IP field: in 2018, *Managing Intellectual Property* included her among the “50 Most Influential People in IP”; in 2020, *World Intellectual Property Review* listed her among its “Influential Women in IP”; in 2022, she received the Adepi Award 2022 for her contribution to shaping the interpretation of IP law in Europe.
