* The Decision Establishing the WIPO Permanent Committee on Patent Information and Dealing with Related Matters provides that the meetings of the PCT Committee for Technical Cooperation shall be joint with those of the WIPO Permanent Committee on Patent Information (PCPI); Article 4 of the Organizational Rules of PCPI provides that any meeting of the Committee for Technical Cooperation established pursuant to Article 56 of the Patent Cooperation Treaty shall as a rule be a joint meeting with the PCPI, and that the meetings shall be presided over by the Chairman of the PCPI. The PCT will not yet be in force when the present session of the PCT Interim Committee on Technical Cooperation meets. It would seem to be, however, within the intent of the said Decision that the measures contemplated for the PCT Committee for Technical Cooperation be applied also to the PCT Interim Committee for Technical Cooperation. This is why it is planned that the meetings of the PCT Interim Committee for Technical Cooperation will, in its present session, be joint with those of the PCPI and this is why there seems to be no need to provide for the election of officers for the present session of the said Interim Committee.
