 - (i) Experience of the International Searching Authorities concerning the present system. Possible measures to increase uniformity of international searches and international search reports, in particular:
 - (a) the indication of citations of particular relevance and of certain special categories of documents cited (Administrative Instructions, Sections 505 and 507); experience with the method of identifying patent documents cited in the international search report (Administrative Instructions, Section 503(a))
 - (b) experience with the application of Article 17(2)(a) of the PCT, in particular with the requirements for carrying out a meaningful search
 - (c) the unity of invention required under Article 17(3)(a) of the PCT and its practical implications
 - (d) extent and depth of search required under Article 15(4)
 - (ii) The usefulness of international search reports in the national phase
 - (iii) Experience in (and assessment of usefulness of) applying uniform procedure for several kinds of searches (e.g., international, regional, national) carried out by the Office which acts as International Searching Authority.

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- 2. The international preliminary examination
 - (i) Experience of the International Preliminary Examining Authorities concerning the present system and of the application of Article 33(1) of the PCT, in particular:
 - (a) the international preliminary examination report: consideration of the adequacy of the present format and procedure, desirability of changes and of comments related to documents cited in the international search report
 - (b) the communication with the applicant and amendments before the International Preliminary Examining Authority
 - (ii) the usefulness of international preliminary examination reports for the national phase
