
The PADOS system

- PADOS is the web browser system for Offices to order documents for International Applications
 - An initial version of PADOS was developed in early 2011
 - The system was piloted in 2011 and is now in production use
 - PADOS replaces the PCT-COR system (since January 2012)

PADOS – getting started

- Send an email to pctcid@wipo.int
- Receive login information (username, password)
- Set up a PCT-EDI account
- Login for the first time and set up options

PADOS Processes

- Setup delivery details at the first login
 - Notification email address(es) (separated by ;)
 - Media –always PCT-EDI
 - Delivery address
- Setup document profile(s) at the first login
 - Choose the types of documents required for each IA
 - Multiple profiles are allowed; the profile is selected when ordering or subscribing
- Start using PADOS
 - Order / subscribe documents for Applications
 - Download document packages using PCT-EDI

PADOS Ordering / Subscription

- Order documents
 - Select the document types profile
 - Upload a list of IAs (text file)
 - Submit
 - All currently available documents for the IAs listed are sent to PCT-EDI (small batches (<50mb) also available for download direct from PADOS)
- Subscribe for documents
 - Select the document types profile
 - Upload a list of IAs (text file)
 - Submit
 - All documents arriving in the future for the IAs listed are sent to PCT-EDI (small batches (<50mb) also available for download direct from PADOS)

PADOS - rationale for removing PCT-COR

The PCT COR system was introduced in 2002/3 and has not been significantly updated since.

- It is based on old versions of PCT database libraries and JAVA – it has become difficult to install
- The electronic document delivery formats are no-longer compatible with the latest formats sent by PCT
- Document types limited to A20 / R87

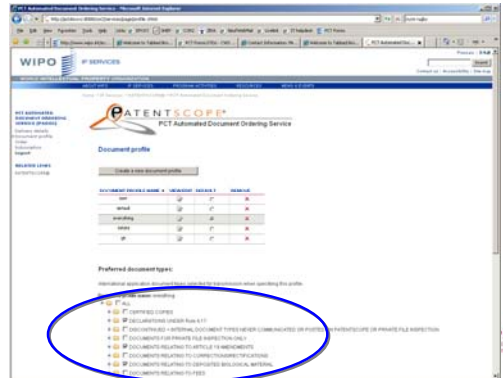

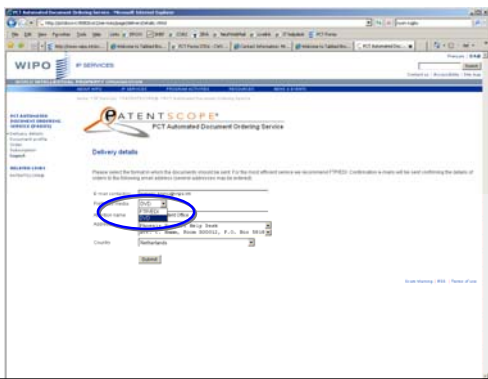

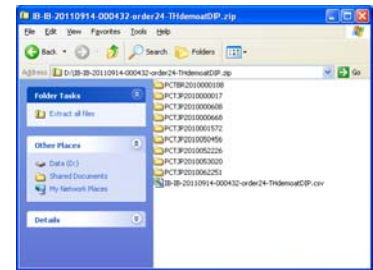

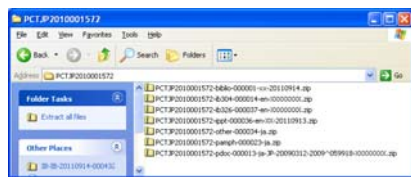

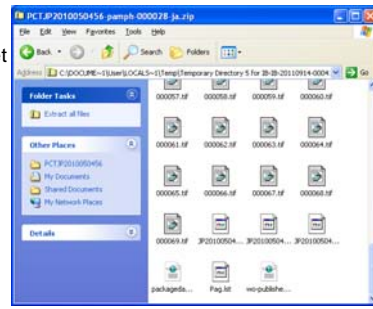
