
Agent's right to practice for ePCT-Filing with RO/IB

- Annex C of the <u>PCT Applicant's Guide</u>
- Additional validations have been introduced in ePCT-Filing
- Users are required to confirm that the agent is entitled to practice before RO/IB
- If not confirmed:
 - ☐ The status of 'agent' will be automatically changed to 'address for correspondence' when the draft is saved
 - Any signature or PoA related to the agent will be automatically deleted

Filing – Priority Claims (1)


■ If the filing date of the earlier application is outside the 12 months priority period but within 2 months following that period, a checkbox to request restoration of the right of priority is displayed





Filing – Priority Claims (2)

If selected RO does not accept requests for restoration of priority, ePCT validation will advise to change to RO/IB but will no longer prevent filing






Filing – Names: reminder about the 2017 PCT Assembly Understanding (1)

■ Where a 90% reduction of the international filing fee is calculated, a validation has been added to remind users about the importance of including <u>all</u> the applicants on the request form at the time of filing, as per the <u>2017</u> <u>PCT Assembly Understanding</u>




Filing – Names: reminder about the 2017 PCT Assembly Understanding (2)






Validation of telephone numbers

- Information box added for telephone numbers advising the full international format to be used and that only certain non-numerical characters are allowed
- Although fax is not recommended by the IB, if you need to indicate a fax number for the RO, ISA or IPEA, the same info box has been added







Method of sending PCT Forms


- PCT Forms issued by IB (including RO/IB) are no longer sent in paper format but by 'Email only'
- Options 'Paper' or 'Paper & Email' have been removed for Filing – Parties, 92bis Action, Chapter II Demand Action, Address Book





Filing – adding a translation required for international publication



Declaration under Rule 4.17(i)


■ When preparing a Declaration under Rule 4.17(i) for more than one inventor, regardless selecting the inventors one by one, or using the multi-select feature, the Declaration is now rendered consistently with all inventors listed together (potentially reduces the number of pages of the RO/101)

Payment method for ePCT filings to RO/IB (1)


- Online payment' function in ePCT is only used to pay filing related fees for direct filings with RO/IB
- Online payment' is now the sole default value



Choose to pay at the time of filing or later using the 'Payment number' link in the email confirming the IA filing in ePCT or using the 'Online payment' action



Full-text version of ISR/WOSA for published IAs (1)



Full-text version of ISR/WOSA for published IAs (2)



ePCT Timeline


Clarification added as to possible reasons that might affect the current target date for international publication





ePCT Action – Chapter II Demand (1)

- After submitting a Chapter II Demand using ePCT, it is routed automatically to the IPEA without any need for the applicant to send a separate copy to the IPEA
- Pop-up added to remind users





ePCT Action – Chapter II Demand (2)

- An additional validation has been added to ensure that the language of publication is indicated as the language for international preliminary examination (IPE) if that language is accepted by the selected IPEA
- Example
 - □ IPEA/RU accepts Russian and English
 - ■Publication language = Russian
 - □ Language for IPE and of Chapter II Demand will be set to Russian by default



ePCT Action – Chapter II Demand for IPEA/US (1)


■ If the name selected for signature of the Demand Form PCT/IPEA/401 has a USPTO registration number associated with it in the Names section, that registration number will be automatically added to the text string signature in the signature field





ePCT Action – Chapter II Demand for IPEA/US (2)


■ If no USPTO registration number is associated, an information panel will remind the user that, to comply with US requirements, the text string signature should contain the registration number





Access Rights


Added a reminder: IMPORTANT – at least 2 persons should have eOwner access rights to each filed IA or draft New IA in order to facilitate access rights management






Address Book – multilingual entries

Maintain contact details in both non-Latin publication languages and the equivalent transliteration in English



Address Book – Notification about renaming (1)

■ If Address Book renamed by an eOwner, automatic notification sent by email to all users with access rights








Address Book – Notification about renaming (2)


