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SCIT WORK PROGRAM FOR THE 2000-01 BIENNIUM

Document prepared by the International Bureau

1. The IT Strategic Implementation Plan, which was sent out by Circular SCIT 2469, dated September 24, 1999 (or 2472 in the French and Spanish languages), contains the strategic initiatives of WIPO's core business processes for the period 1999 to 2003. The SCIT Work Program for the years 2000-01 should reflect the individual tasks for implementing the priority initiatives and which are relevant to the scope of competence of the SCIT.
2. In addition, the new SCIT Work Program should contain those tasks which form part of the current Work Program of the Standing Committee (adopted by the SCIT at its second Plenary session on February 12, 1999) and are of such importance that they qualify to be carried over into the new millennium.
3. The International Bureau has prepared, for consideration by the Plenary, a draft SCIT Work Program which is given in Annex 1 to this document. The principle of grouping the Tasks in accordance with their objectives, as introduced by the SCIT Plenary at its second session, has been maintained when drafting the new Work Program.

Although the SCIT Plenary has not yet agreed on the priority projects of the IT Strategic Implementation Plan, the IB has made a preliminary selection of some of the activities resulting from that Plan for inclusion in the Work Program of the Standing Committee. As a consequence, the IB included some new tasks in the SCIT Work Program, or modified existing tasks, in order to reflect the responsibilities of the SCIT with respect to the initiatives outlined in the said IT Strategic Implementation Plan; those tasks are marked in the first or second columns of Annex 1. It is understood that this draft Work Program needs further review on the basis of the conclusions expected to be reached under agenda Item 4 of the SCIT Plenary session (IT Strategic Plan) in December 1999.

4. A list of those Tasks of the current Work Program which have not been dealt with in past years and which, in the view of the International Bureau, do not have sufficient relevance to be included in the Work Program for the next biennium is contained in Annex 2 to this document. Annex 2 also contains some Tasks from the current Work Program for which future work will be part of specific projects included in the SCIT IT Strategic Implementation Plan. These Tasks, in the view of the IB, should not be included in the new Work Program to avoid unnecessary duplication.

5. The SCIT Plenary is invited to discuss the enclosed draft and adopt the SCIT Work Program for the 2000-01 biennium.
