The Handbook is an important tool for both the novice and the more experienced industrial property information user.

The various Standards, Recommendations and Guidelines reproduced in this Handbook have been drafted with the help of groups of experts from many countries in meetings organized by WIPO and are the result of international cooperation in the field of industrial property.
