1. Opening of the session

Brief description: The Director General of WIPO will open the session and deliver his welcoming remarks.

2. Election of Officers

Brief description: For the current session, the Secretariat has received the nomination of H.E. Patricia Benedetti, Ambassador and P.R. of El Salvador to WTO and WIPO for election as Chair, and Ms. Beverly Perry, Senior Policy Advisor at the Intellectual Property Office of the United Kingdom, as Vice-Chair.

Invited action: *the CDIP will be invited to elect the Chair and Vice-Chairs, for a period of one year.*

- (a) Director General's Report on the Implementation of the Development Agenda

Brief description: The annual report by the Director General provides an overview of the activities undertaken by WIPO for the implementation of the Development Agenda and its mainstreaming across relevant programs of the Organization. - (b) Report on the Web Forum Established under the "Project on Intellectual Property and Technology Transfer: Common Challenges – Building Solutions" after its Integration into the New WIPO INSPIRE Platform
