WIPO NATIONAL DESIGN COMPETITION 2023

To raise further awareness on the role of intellectual property in design as a key driver of economic growth in Nigeria, the WIPO Nigeria Office (WNO) in collaboration with the National Gallery of Art (NGA) launches its 2023 National Design Competition for professionals and students with the theme "IP and Sustainable Development: Designing the Nigeria of my Dreams". Participants are required to develop designs on this theme.

Design has a multi-dimensional application in the sustainable development of nations. Nigeria has a rich pedigree of artistic tradition that produced intricate and peculiar artistic styles globally accepted. This competition challenges participants to the concepts of design and sustainable development.

Who can participate?

The national design competition is open to two categories of persons:

- 1) **Students:** Primary and secondary school students from institutions in Abuja. Please note that entries in the students' category are restricted to Drawing, Painting, Sculpture and Collage based on the theme.
- 2) **Professionals:** Design professionals (including students of tertiary institutions) in Nigeria. Please note that entries in the professionals' category are restricted to Graphics Design Including Print Designs, 2D or 3D Illustration and Drawing based on the theme.

Entry requirements:

- 1. Entries will be submitted in soft copy.
- a) A soft copy of the design entry should be submitted on or before September 29, 2023 to nigeria.office@wipo.int

Pléase note that only shortlisted candidates will be required to provide hard copies of their entries at the competition exhibition to be held in October 2023.

- 2. Entries should be submitted with the following details:
- a)Student category: Name of author, names of parents/guardians, school, phone number of author, phone number of parents/guardians, email address of parents/guardians, means of identification of its author.
- b)Professional category: Name, phone number, email address, city, means of identification of its author.
- 3. Plagiarism of any sort will result in disqualification.
- 4. Al generated works are not eligible for submission, and will be disqualified.
- 5. Submissions received after the announced deadline will not be considered.

All entries and relevant documentation should be submitted on or before September 29, 2023.

Winners of the competition will be announced at the Design Exhibition to be held in October 2023.
