Re: Revision of WIPO Standard ST.3 – EU

./ The International Bureau of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) would like to inform your Office that at the Sixth Session of the Committee on WIPO Standards (CWS) the Delegation of Austria, on behalf of the European Union, proposed the inclusion of the two-letter code “EU” to represent the European Union in WIPO Standard ST.3.

In view of the proposal, the International Bureau would like to inform your Office that the following changes in Annex A to WIPO Standard ST.3 should be carried out:

Inclusion of:

- European Union (English name)
- Union européenne (French name)
- Unión Europea (Spanish name)

and its two-letter code EU.
