Dr. Mtoba is a member of the 2014 Australia B20 Human Capital Task Force and was co-Chairman of the 2013 Russia B20 Task Force on Transparency and Anti-Corruption.

Dr. Mtoba was the first African black woman to be appointed board member of Deloitte. She was later appointed deputy Chairman and finally Chairman of Deloitte in 2005. Today Dr. Mtoba is a senior partner at Deloitte in the Executive Office.

She is a past member of the Board of the United Nations Global Compact, the world's largest voluntary corporate citizenship initiative looking to meet the Millennium Development Goals for a sustainable and inclusive global economy.

She holds an Honorary Doctorate of Commerce from the University of Limpopo in South Africa for her contribution to the advancement of the accounting profession and for her contribution to addressing national and global social issues.

She is a qualified chartered accountant and the past chairman of Deloitte Southern Africa and the past President of Business Unity South Africa.

She is also the chairperson of Council of the University of Pretoria.
