Biographical Note

A Member of the Quebec Bar, Mr. Bisson is Head of International Registration Systems Legal Section at the World Intellectual Property Organization, a Geneva-based agency of the United Nations (<http://www.wipo.int>). His previous positions with WIPO included overseeing the examination and registration activities under the Madrid system for the international registration of marks and the Hague Agreement for the international registration of industrial designs. He joined WIPO in 1995 after a short stint with the Canadian Trade-Mark Opposition Board. Before that, he was Senior Legal Advisor with the Federal Government, a position he held concurrently with his duties at the University of Ottawa where he was lecturing on the legal aspects of transfer of technology.
