Jurisdiction - General Information

Argentina has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since February 10, 1967. It is not a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT).

Argentina is also part of the regional IP information platform [LATIPAT](#), and a member of the "SISTEMA DE COOPERACIÓN SOBRE ASPECTOS DE INFORMACIÓN OPERACIONAL Y DE PROPIEDAD INDUSTRIAL" ([PROSUR](#)).

Argentina has an [Online Register](#) and an [Online Gazette](#) (Boletín).

Features and search functionalities

The online patent register has a **Spanish interface**.

Through the patent register you can retrieve information on **Legal Status** and **Fee Payment**.

The patent register can also be searched by **Applicant Name** and by **Priority Data**.

The online gazette is published weekly in Spanish. It is searchable by number and downloadable in PDF format. The editions of the last 12 months are available online.

Patents of some PROSUR members including Argentina can also be searched on the [Spanish search interface](#). Searches can be done by **Priority Data** and by **Applicant/Inventor Name**.
