

## ARABPAT - AB

### Jurisdiction - General Information

ARABPAT is not an authority issuing patents but a patent information dissemination platform in Arab countries and a member of the ESPACENET family.

ARABPAT was initiated as a cooperative project between the member countries of the Agadir Agreement (Egypt, Jordan, Morocco and Tunisia) and supported by the European Patent Office (EPO), the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), and the Moroccan Office for Industrial and Commercial Property (OMPIC).

Currently, ARABPAT offers access to patent data of Egypt, Jordan, Morocco, Saudi Arabia, and Tunisia.

### Online Patent Register and Online Gazette

Even though an **Online Register** is not provided, a [bibliographic patent database](#) is available online where legal status information will become available in the future.

### Features and search functionalities

The database has an **English interface**. It can be searched by **Applicant/Inventor Name**, by **PCT Application/Publication Number**, and by **Priority Data** (by priority number only).

In some cases, you can deduce basic information about **Legal Status** (e.g. grant) from the bibliographic record or from the PDF copy. Access to the **Full Publications** is also available for a large number of patents of Egypt, Morocco, Saudi Arabia, and Tunisia.
