Jurisdiction - General Information

The Central African Republic has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since November 19, 1963. It has also been a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since January 24, 1978, but it can be designated only through the African Intellectual Property Organization (OAPI).
