Jurisdiction - General Information

Chile has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since June 14, 1991. It has also been a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since June 2, 2009. In addition, it is a party to the Budapest Treaty on the International Recognition of the Deposit of Microorganisms for the Purposes of Patent Procedure.

Chile is also part of the regional IP information platform [LATIPAT](#), and a member of the "SISTEMA DE COOPERACIÓN SOBRE ASPECTOS DE INFORMACIÓN OPERACIONAL Y DE PROPIEDAD INDUSTRIAL" ([PROSUR](#)).

Features and search functionalities

The online patent register has a **Spanish interface**.

Through the patent register you can retrieve information on **Legal Status** and **Fee Payment**.

The patent register can also be searched by **Applicant/Inventor Name** and by **Priority Data**.

Patents of PROSUR members including Chile can be searched by using the [Spanish search interface](#). Searches can be done by **Priority Data** and by **Applicant/Inventor Name**.

In the online gazette only the communications of the last month are displayed.
