Features and search functionalities

The online gazette ("Boletim da Propriedade Intelectual") is published every three months in Portuguese and can be downloaded in PDF format. The coverage is from 2011 to present.

A list is shown but only the issues from 2016 onwards can be downloaded. Registration is required to open the document, which can be retrieved against a fee. The gazette currently covers trademarks, patents, denominations of origin/geographical indications, industrial designs, and publication of copyright.

Additional Information

Particularities of patent protection in Cabo Verde

The Legislative Decree No. 4/2007 of August 20 Sub-Section VI provides a **Supplementary Protection Certificate (SPC)** for medicines and phytopharmaceutical products.

The PCT regulations provide that an international application may claim priority to a jurisdiction which is neither member of the PCT nor of the Paris Convention, but is a World Trade Organization (WTO) member, such as Cabo Verde.
