The Niger has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since July 5, 1964. It has also been a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since March 21, 1993, but it can be designated only through the African Intellectual Property Organization (OAPI).
