

PORTUGAL - PT

Jurisdiction - General Information

Portugal has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since July 7, 1884. It has also been a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since November 24, 1992. In addition, it is a party to the Budapest Treaty on the International Recognition of the Deposit of Microorganisms for the Purposes of Patent Procedure.

Portugal is a member of the European Patent Organization (EPO).

Online Patent Register and Online Gazette

Portugal has an [Online Register](#) and an [Online Gazette](#) (Boletim da Propriedade Industrial).

Features and search functionalities

The online patent register has [English](#) and [Portuguese](#) interfaces. It contains information about Portuguese patents and utility models; and PCT applications and European patents designating Portugal.

Through the patent register you can retrieve information on **Legal Status**, **Fee Payment**, and **Supplementary Protection Certificates (SPCs)**.

The patent register can also be searched by **Applicant Name** and by **PCT Application Number**.

It is possible to access the **Full Publications** through a link to Espacenet at the bottom of the bibliographic record.

The online gazette is published every working day in Portuguese and contains links to the complete patent application that includes the correspondent Portuguese search report with written opinion. The gazette is searchable by date and can be displayed in PDF format. The current coverage is from 2004 to present.

European patents designating Portugal can be searched in the patent register. The European Patent Register is otherwise also accessible at this [link](#).
