Jurisdiction - General Information

Paraguay has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since May 28, 1994. It is not a Contracting Party to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT).

Paraguay is also part of the regional IP information platform [LATIPAT](#) and a member of the "SISTEMA DE COOPERACIÓN SOBRE ASPECTOS DE INFORMACIÓN OPERACIONAL Y DE PROPIEDAD INDUSTRIAL" ([PROSUR](#)).

Online Patent Register and Online Gazette

Paraguay has an [Online Register](#) and an [Online Gazette](#).

Features and search functionalities

The online patent register comprises a database of applications (Boletín de Solicitudes Presentadas) and granted patents (Consulta Patentes). It has a **Spanish interface**.

Basic information about **Legal Status** (e.g. grant) can be inferred from the publication data in the section on granted patents.

The online gazette is published monthly in Spanish. Its current coverage is from 2015 to present.

Patents of some PROSUR members can be searched by using the Spanish search interface. Searches can be done by **Priority Data** and **Applicant/Inventor Name**.
