Jurisdiction - General Information

Romania has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property since October 6, 1920. It has also been a Contracting Party to the European Patent Convention and to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since July 23, 1979.

Romania is a member of the European Patent Organization (EPO).

Features and search functionalities

The online patent register has an **English** and **Romanian interface** and allows searching for European patents designating Romania by: **Publication number, Application number, Patent number, Filing date, EP grant date, EP Publication date of the Romanian translation, Romanian title Applicant Name.**

There is also a patent database available at this [link](#), with a **Romanian interface**, which only provides bibliographic data and the patent description in PDF format.

Romanian patents can also be searched through the publication server at this [link](#).

Fee Payment and **Legal Status** information can only be retrieved for European patents and not for national patents through the Online Register, while some legal status information for national patents can only be retrieved through the publication server indicated above, using the publication codes (A0-A9, B1-B9, U1-U9).

Full Publications can be obtained through a link to Espacenet provided for each document.

The online gazette is published monthly in Romanian. It can be searched by number and downloaded in PDF format. The coverage is from 1994 to present.

Lists of **Supplementary Protection Certificates (SPCs)** are downloadable for the years from 2007 to present from the Online Gazette search page.

European patents designating Romania can be searched in the patent register by **Applicant Name**. The European Patent Register is otherwise also accessible at this [link](#).
