Jurisdiction - General Information

Ukraine has been a Contracting Party to the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property and to the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT) since December 25, 1991. In addition, it is a party to the Budapest Treaty on the International Recognition of the Deposit of Microorganisms for the Purposes of Patent Procedure and the Patent Law Treaty (PLT).

Online Patent Register and Online Gazette

Ukraine has an [Online Register](#) and an [Online Gazette](#).

Features and search functionalities

The online patent register has an **English, Ukrainian and Russian interface**. It contains information about Ukrainian patents and utility models.

Through the patent register you can retrieve information on **Legal Status, PCT National Phase Entry, Fee Payment**, and access the **Full Publications**.

The patent register can also be searched by **PCT Application Number**, by **Applicant/Inventor Name**, and by **Priority Data**.

The online gazette is presented as a patent database, with a search interface and a menu which allows you to choose among several subsets such as applications accepted for examination or granted patents. The results are also presented in html format like patent database records. The coverage is from 2006 to present.

Search tips

The Ukraine Patent Office offers a bundle of patent databases. In the **Online Register** you can search by **PCT Application Number**, e.g., "(86) PCT Application Number" PCT/CN03/00069.

PCT National Phase Entry information is reported on the "Details" page; see INID code 85.

To retrieve information about **Legal Status**, see the green button on the top right corner of the "Details" page, labelled "valid". Please note that there are different databases, e.g. for reporting status of examined, lapsed or invalid patents.

Fee Payment information is available, e.g. for "Information and Reference System (IRS)" a200600001, see "FEES" [here](#) leading to the "Invention and Utility Model Applications Prosecution State".

When carrying out a file inspection, a list of events is available, but not the documents.

Patents **Full Publications** are available but split in their different components.
