This Circular is addressed to your Office in its capacity as a receiving Office (RO), International Searching Authority (ISA), Authority specified for supplementary search (SISA), International Preliminary Examining Authority (IPEA) and/or designated or elected Office (DO/EO) under the Patent Cooperation Treaty (PCT). It is also being sent to interested intergovernmental organizations as well as certain non-governmental organizations representing users of the PCT System.

This Circular, following PCT Circular C.PCT 1423 concerning modifications of certain Forms relating to the ISA, SISA, IPEA and the International Bureau, concerns proposals for change to the Standard for the Filing and Processing in Electronic Form of International Applications (Annex F of the Administrative Instructions under the PCT) related to the PCT Demand (PCT/IPEA/401) Form.

## **DESCRIPTION OF CHANGES**

Proposed changes to Annex F and its appendices are set out in the following Proposal for Change (PFC) file (available at: http://www.wipo.int/pct/efiling\_standard/en/pfc\_files.htm):

 PCT/EF/PFC 14/002 (Modification of the demand and related DTDs with the addition of elements and attributes for the next version of the PCT/IPEA/401 Form), proposal by the International Bureau.

The proposed changes to Annex F and its appendices are to address the requirements for rendering the revised version of PCT/IPEA/401 (January 1, 2015) by the IPEA.
