

Georgian “Law on Design” directly states that Typeface/Type Font can be protected as a design.

As for the Graphic User Interface, the law does not have direct indication, but it can be considered as an appearance of the product, therefore it is encompassed by the definition of the design - a design is the appearance of the whole product or its part resulting from the features of the product proper, including lines, contours, colors, shape, texture and/or material or decoration of the product, and - a product is any industrial or handmade item, including packaging, get-up, graphical symbol, printing type, component part intended to be incorporated into a complex product, except a computer program.

Also the same can be said regarding an Icon, it is not directly mentioned in the law. However, as it is a graphic symbol, it can be protected in classes 14-04 and 32-00.

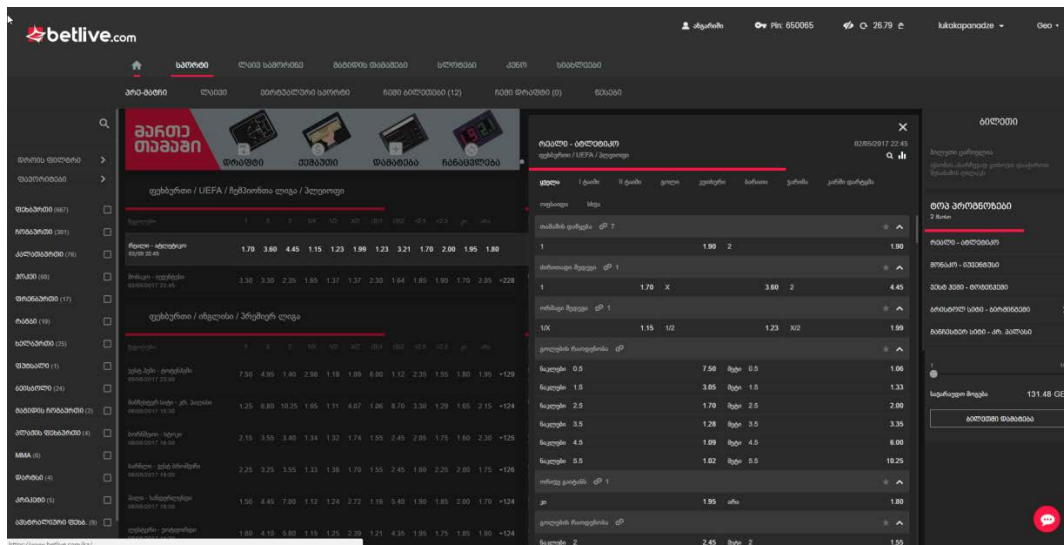
