Explanatory Notes

1. On the following pages is given the inventory of patent documents, covering the period January 1, 1920, to September 30, 2021, forming the PCT Minimum Documentation according to PCT Rule 34.1.

2. The different kinds of patent documents issued by each Office falling within the PCT Minimum Documentation according to PCT Rule 34.1 are arranged in the fourth column. The two-letter code from WIPO Standard <u>ST.3</u> for the State of the Office, or for the intergovernmental organization is given in the second column. The letter code from WIPO Standard <u>ST.16</u> that corresponds to each kind of those patent documents is given in the third column. The codes are indicated for information only – under PCT Rule 34.1(d), where an application is republished, no International Searching Authority is obliged to keep all versions in its documentation. Further information on kind codes used by Offices can be found in <u>Part 7.3.2</u> of the WIPO Handbook on Industrial Property Information and Documentation.

3. The fifth column gives the publication years of the documents that are part of the PCT Minimum Documentation. However, for patent documents referred to in PCT Rule 34.1(e), the requirements for an International Searching Authority to include those patent documents in its documentation will depend on the official language(s) of the International Searching Authority and the availability of English language abstracts. The sixth column of the inventory indicates the coverage of the authority file compliant with WIPO Standard <u>ST.37</u> if an Office has provided the International Bureau with the authority file or a link to where the authority file is hosted. The name of the issuing Office or organization in the first column is linked to the page on the <u>WIPO website</u> hosting the authority file of the Office, or to the page on the website of the Office or organization hosting the authority file.
