

Core issues – Mandate for IGC 31

- Definition of misappropriation
- Beneficiaries
- Subject matter
- Objectives
- What TK subject matter is entitled to protection at an international level
- Exceptions and limitations
- Relationship with the public domain

Objectives

Themes reflected in document WIPO/GRTKF/IC/31/4, according to the IGC Chair's Information Note:

- a. Prevent the misappropriation/misuse/unauthorized use/unfair and inequitable uses of TK;
- b. *Enable beneficiaries to control ways in which their TK is used beyond the traditional and customary context;*
- c. Promote the equitable sharing of benefits arising from their use with prior informed consent or approval and involvement/fair and equitable compensation, as necessary;
- d. Encourage [and protect] [tradition-based] creation and innovation; and
- e. Prevent the grant of erroneous IP / patent rights over TK and TK associated with GRs.

- Are all of these directly related to IP?

Beneficiaries

- IPLCs
- Nations?

- National authority / Competent authority

Subject matter

- Subject matter
- Eligibility criteria
- Which is the appropriate place to deal with the criteria for eligibility? Are eligibility criteria needed? Or could the scope of protection and exceptions and limitations define what is to be protected?

Scope of protection

- Tiered approach
 - Different kinds or levels of rights (Economic rights? Moral rights?)
 - Depending on the nature and characteristics of the subject matter, the level of control retained by the beneficiaries and its degree of diffusion
- Distinction between:
 - TK available to the general public
 - ...
 - Secret TK, still controlled by its holders
- Opportunity for balance?

Exceptions and limitations

- Conditions to be established at a national level?
- Linked to discussion on tiered approach and public domain

Relationship with the public domain

- Other related terms:
 - Publicly available
 - Prior art

- Is a definition really necessary?

Definition of misappropriation

- 2 options:
 - Any access or use without prior informed consent or approval and involvement, and, where applicable, without mutually agreed terms, for whatever purpose
 - Acquisition of TK through improper means or a breach of confidence, and which results in a violation of national law in the provider country
- Is a definition really necessary?
