The International Bureau of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) presents its compliments to His Excellency the Minister for Foreign Affairs and has the honor to communicate to him, at the request of the Government of the Hellenic Republic, a reproduction of three State emblems for which protection is requested under Article 6<sup>ter</sup> of the Paris Convention for the Protection of Industrial Property as revised at The Hague on November 6, 1925, at London on June 2, 1934, at Lisbon on October 31, 1958, and at Stockholm on July 14, 1967.

It is recalled that the protection of armorial bearings, flags and other State emblems of the countries of the Paris Union for the Protection of Industrial Property, and of official signs and hallmarks indicating control and warranty adopted by those countries, is provided for in Article 6<sup>ter</sup> of the Paris Convention as revised at The Hague, London, Lisbon and Stockholm and that, consequently, the communication of the State emblems mentioned above concerns all the countries of the Paris Union, whether party to the Stockholm Act, the Lisbon Act, the London Act or the Hague Act.
